## What sells at a Flea Market.

- **Kitchenware & Appliances:** Pyrex glassware, Le Creuset cookware, small kitchen appliances (mixers, blenders), and castiron pans.
- **Furniture & Home Decor:** Solid wood furniture, mid-century modern pieces, mirrors, bookshelves, and unique vintage decor items.
- **Tools & Outdoor Gear:** Power tools, gardening equipment, bicycles, and camping gear.
- **Collectibles & Vintage Items:** vinyl records, toys, and advertising memorabilia (signs, crates).
- **For kids- Gently used:** toys, outdoor playhouses, bicycles, scooters, books, games, puzzles, sports equipment
- **Books & Media:** Books, CDs, DVDs, and video games.

## What does not sell well at a flea market.

- **Broken items, old computer equipment, and outdated software.**
- **Used car seats, helmets, older exercise equipment.**
- **Electronics:** Old TVs, monitors, printers, and phones are usually avoided by buyers.
- **Broken Furniture/Used Linens**
- **Outdated Media & Books:**
- **Mismatched coffee mugs, cheap plastic storage, and old, scratched non-stick pans.**
